How to score

- Play 13 rounds, one for each double from the 12–12 down to the double-blank.
- After each round, record the pips each player is still holding. The player who went out scores 0.
- **The lowest cumulative total after the final round wins.**
- Hand sizes: 2–4 players → 15 tiles · 5–6 players → 12 tiles · 7–8 players → 10 tiles · 9–10 players → 8 tiles.

The double-blank scores zero by the standard rules, because it has no pips. Counting it as 50 is a popular house rule, not an official one — if you want it, agree it before you deal.
